



✕ Sailing Cruise around Milos / Adamas – Kleftiko – Poliegos

Interests: nautical experience, sea & sun, nature

After meeting the crew at Adamas port, you will board the spacious boat and start your semi-private sailing adventure around 10 AM. Passing the coastline and leaving the Milos bay behind, you will sail past traditional fishing villages of Skinopi, Klima, Areti, and Fourkovouni adorned with picturesque little houses -called "sirmata"- built by the seaside. Then you will visit Arkoudes, a lava rock complex that takes its name from its characteristic shape; the form of a bear. Opening the sails you will then head to the impressive Cape Vani. Your first swimming stop will be at the natural bay of Kalogries, where you will be able to dive into the transparent turquoise waters right from the yacht. Your next wow-stop is the cave of Sikia, where you will be able to revel in the view and explore the entrance and its famous hall with the hole in the ceiling. The colorful beach of Agios Ioannis follows the stunning Sikia cave. The tour will then continue to the famous pirates bay of Kleftiko, one of the most instagammable locations in the world. During the 2-hour stop, the crew will guide you to the best caves in which to swim and snorkel. After your sea adventures, you will recharge your batteries with a scrumptious lunch on board before setting sail to the majestic beach of Gerakas and its hot spring as well as the colorful beach of Firlingos. Finally, you will pass by the abandoned Sulphur Mines and sail towards your last swim stop of the day, the amazing bay of Galazia Nera, in Poliegos. Coming back on board, the captain will set course for your disembarkation point in Pollonia, passing by the islands of Kimolos and Agios Eustathios. Arrival in Pollonia is expected at 8 PM where your transfer will be waiting for you if you wish to go straight back to Adamas.

✕ **Sunset Cruise around Milos Island**

After meeting the crew at Adamas port at 13:30, a van will be ready to take you to Agia Kiriaki, where you will board the catamaran and start your cruise around 14:00. After a short sail, you will reach the pristine Gerakas beach, your first swim stop. This beach is also called Ammotsoulithres and it is famous for its hot springs that can be found on the side of the beach. Continuing south, you will reach we will arrive at your main stop of the day, the famous old pirates bay of Kleftiko, where you will want to go jump right into the crystal clear sea, snorkel, and explore the numerous sea caves. The crew will guide you to the best places to swim to and a well-deserved lunch will be waiting for you when you return to the boat. Finally, as the captain turns the boat to start heading back, you will pass some more stunning locations such as the cave of Sykia with its collapsed ceiling, and the beaches of Agios Ioannis, Triades, and Agathia, before reaching your final swimming spot of the day, the beach of Kalogries. Then, turning at the impressive Cape Vani, the boat will cross the bay and pass by Arkoudes, a complex of lava rocks shaped like a bear, as its name suggests. Your nautical adventure will finish at sunset time, passing by the traditional fishing villages of Skinopi, Klima, Areti, and Fourkovouni, with their colorful little houses called Sirmata. Arrival at Adamas port is expected after sunset.
